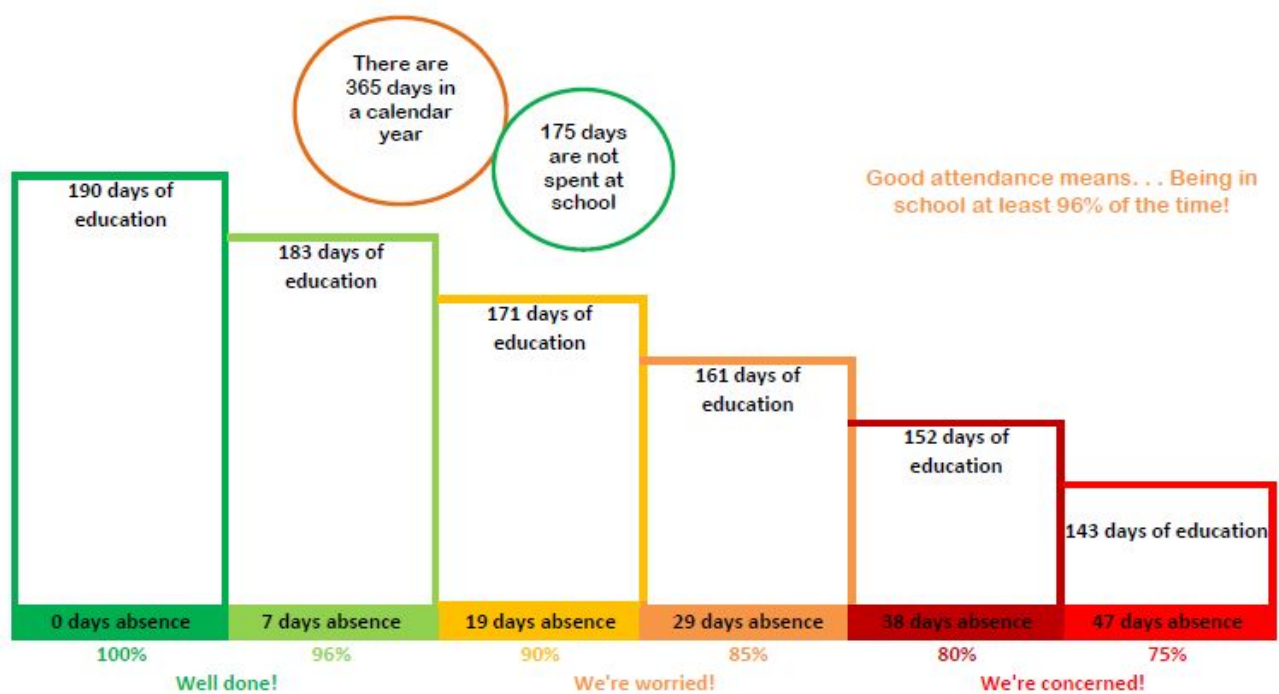
Debatemate
