After visiting the bunker to observe operations, Churchill famously said, 'Never in the field of human conflict was so much owed, by so many to so few...'.

The children had the opportunity to take part in a workshop, visit the control room, learn how the battle was masterminded, observe and handle artefacts, dress up in military uniform and to meet a WWII veteran. We all enjoyed the visit and learnt a lot about our local contribution to this countries' history.
