

## **Creative Hair Day!**

So we are looking to try something different: we are asking pupils to become creative hair stylists for the day. It might be a mohawk wig, some washable (not permanent!) spray-on hair colour, or your child's locks and tresses sculpted into either a spider, a cup cake or a

pouring drink.



Rather than ask for a £1, which will be difficult to manage as the school is avoiding any handling of cash, we ask that parents donate a book for their child's class.

If your household is anything like Mr. Tucker's then it's likely to have a few children's books that are in excellent condition, have been read and are just sitting on the shelf. Rather than have them collect dust, we are asking, in exchange for participating in Creative Hair Day, pupils donate a book that

can be added to their class library. Children may even wish to write a message to future readers on the inside of the front cover.

All books will be quarantined for 96+ hours before being added to the class library.

Adults and children are allowed to take any book for **FREE** and keep **FOREVER!** We value the importance of reading and this is one way of reducing the literacy gap for all.

#### UNIFORM REMINDER

From Tuesday 5 January 2021, we will expect all children to return to school in their full uniform.

Boys and girls wear:

- A white polo shirt
- School jumper/cardigan
- Grey trousers, skirt or pinafore
- White socks
- Black formal school shoes (no trainers)

In the summer, girls can wear a light summer dress.

In Year 5 & 6 pupils must wear a white shirt with a school tie. Ties can be bought from the school office for £4 each.

The only exception to this rule will be on the days that your child has P.E. They will be required to come to school in clothing that is suitable for P.E., ideally trainers, tracksuit bottoms, t-shirt and a hoodie or sweater, as your child may well be enjoying outdoor PE in the bracing weather associated with January and February.


#### **Knowledge Organisers:**

Knowledge organisers are a summary of the key facts and essential knowledge that pupils need about a unit of work or a curriculum subject. All of the information presented is broken down into easily digestible chunks.

We would like parents and pupils to use these at home to learn some




key pieces of information around the topics being studied. Pupils will review, revise and quiz themselves using their knowledge organisers. An example of a year group folder can be seen here:

### **Hot Lunches**

The school's expansion of its hot meal service, dubbed 'DeliveRye' continues to be a success with pupils. We are expanding the hot meal options to include pasta pots, pizza with garlic bread, and we are pleased to introduce a Friday favourite: **fish and chips!** 

The school kitchen is providing packed lunches for all pupils who are eligible for free school meals, this includes children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2. They **must** be ordered in advance and via Parent Pay. We have had a number of children expecting lunch but their parents have not ordered a sandwich pack/hot meal option. **Please note that we are only allowing families** to make menu choices three weeks in advance. This enables us to ensure that we can easily upload more hot menu choices, such as hot dogs and potato wedges.

### **After School clubs**

We have limited spaces in our after school clubs. Bike Ability has completely sold out and we cannot wait to see the amazing progress our children will make as the coaches teach them how to ride a bike without stabilisers. The booking window remains open so it's not too late to secure a place. However, should you change your mind refunds will only be given if the school is able to secure a replacement for your child's place.

Ryefield will continue to use the Sports Premium to subsidise the cost, ensuring that our extra curricular activities remain affordable to all. The draft menu of clubs is as follows:
