

# Ryefield Primary School Uniform Statement



At Ryefield we expect all children to wear school uniform. For pupils it creates a sense of belonging and pride in their school. Ryefield branded uniform can be purchased through our uniform suppliers;

## **School Uniform**

- Grey skirt (knee length), pinafore or grey straight legged trousers
- White polo shirt for **Nursery – Year 2**
- White shirt for **Years 3, 4, 5 and 6**
- Royal blue sweatshirt or cardigan
- White/grey socks (not “trainer socks”) or grey tights
- Blue gingham summer dress/shorts or grey shorts
- Black sensible, low-heeled shoes (no trainers or boots)
- Ties for **Years 3, 4, 5 and 6**

## **PE Uniform**

- Black/Navy tracksuit
- Black/Navy shorts
- Plain White t-shirt
- Sports trainers

## **Other items needed for school**

- **Bags** – it is compulsory for pupils in **Nursery, Reception, Year 1 and Year 2** to have a **royal blue book bag**. Children in **Years 3/4/5/6** should have a school bag, which will fit comfortably in their locker. Large bags should not be brought to school
- **EYFS**- children in Nursery and Reception will need a puddlesuit and pair of wellies that should be left in school
- **Hats** - baseball hats may be worn outside in the summer
- **Hair bands** – must be small and a similar colour to natural hair colour, subdued colours or royal blue
- **Head scarves** – may be worn for religious reasons only, but they must be plain
- **Waterproofs** – it is important that children have a waterproof coat for playtimes
- **Water bottle** – all children should bring a named water bottle to school, which should be metal or plastic and reusable. **NO GLASS BOTTLES**
- **Headphones** –children from **Year 1 to Year 6** should bring headphones to school. Headphones with a microphone are preferable but not essential
- **Pencil case/stationary** - All children in **Years 3- 6** must bring a pencil case to school. It should be labelled. The contents should include: HB pencils, an eraser, a sharpener, a ruler, a highlighter, a glue stick, rounded scissors, black whiteboard pens, either colouring pencils or Crayola twistables. **NO PENS INCLUDING FELT TIP PENS.**



**Pencil cases will be returned at the end of each half term to be replenished.**

## **Rules relating to the wearing of school uniform**

- **Ryefield Uniform** – uniform does not need to have the Ryefield logo on. Plain versions are also encouraged
- **Shirts** - are to be tucked in at the waist
- **Ties** – a clip on/elastic tie is acceptable in place of our standard tie but must be of the same colouring
- **Swimming** – children in Year 4 will need a swimming kit. Details will be given prior to swimming lessons starting
- **Jewellery** - no jewellery at all except for plain stud earrings or for religious reasons. Stud earrings are not to be worn on PE/Swimming days - teachers are not responsible for taking earrings out or looking after them
- **Watches** - watches which must not be smart watches may be worn by children in KS2; the school is not responsible for the safeguarding of such items
- **Trainers** – if you must wear trainers other than for PE it must be for a medical reason and a note must be received
- **Shoes** – please ensure your child can tie their laces if they are wearing laced shoes
- **Hair** – children should have sensible haircuts. Where it is long enough to do so, all children (boys and girls) are required to tie their hair up, this is for both health and safety reasons and to ensure the children look smart and ready for school. Hair accessories should be minimal and plain.
- **Other**- no body paint or transfers, no nail varnish or false nails, no sunglasses unless for medical reasons, no flashing shoes or trainer shoes

Any lost unnamed uniform/items can be located in the main Reception. These will be recycled if not claimed after 2 weeks.
